BACKGROUND:

Beauty Vibes understands that your privacy is important to you and that you care about how your personal data is used and shared online. Any personal data We do collect will only be used as permitted by law.

1. **Definitions and Interpretation**

5. What Data Do We Collect?

- 5.1 Subject to section 5.2, We do not collect any personal data from you. We do not place cookies on your computer or device, nor do We use any other means of data collection.

If you do not want to use our data in this way, please tick the relevant box situated on the form on which we collect your data.
- 6.2.6 To compile market research regarding the quality of our services and products for business planning and regulatory purposes
- 6.2.7 To notify you about changes to our service or products or our site
- 6.2.8 To comply with our legal and regulatory requirements

7. How and Where Do We Store Your Data?

- 7.1 We only keep your personal data for as long as We need to in order to use it as described above in section 6, and/or for as long as We have your permission to keep it.
- 7.2 Your data will be stored on our secure servers in the UK. We will take all reasonable steps to ensure that your data is treated as safely and securely and in accordance with this privacy policy.
